## PROGRAM GOALS

The goals of this 12-hour Oklahoma State Board of Pharmacy approved Immunization Training Program are to:

- Provide comprehensive immunization education and training to Oklahoma pharmacists,
- Provide pharmacists with necessary skills, resources and materials to establish and promote a successful pharmacy-based immunization service,
- Train pharmacists in the identification of at-risk populations needing immunizations,
- Train pharmacists in the safe and effective delivery of immunizations.

## OBJECTIVES

Upon completion of this program, the pharmacist should be able to:

- Explain the basic sciences of vaccines,
- Describe general vaccine safety issues and management of vaccine-related adverse effects,
- Interpret vaccine schedules recommended by vaccines Advisory Committee on Immunization Practices (ACIP),
- Compare and contrast national and state legal issues pertinent to pharmacists administering vaccines,
- Identify and assess children and adults of immunizations needs,
- Identify documentation needs required for pharmacy-based immunization services,
- Discuss reimbursement mechanisms available for immunizations providers,
- Describe the basic components common to physician-pharmacist immunization protocols,
- Demonstrate competency in the safe and effective delivery of immunizations.

## PROGRAM REQUIREMENTS AND CONTINUING EDUCATION CREDIT

Program requirements include 1) completing the 4-hour home-study material prior to attending the on-site classroom program, 2) participating in the entire 8-hour classroom program and 3) proof of your current CPR card.

*CPR NOTE: Although not included in Southwestern's IMMUNIZATION TRAINING PROGRAM, as part of the Program Requirements, you must provide proof of completing CPR training. CPR is NOT PART of the IMMUNIZATION TRAINING PROGRAM. You are responsible for completing CPR training prior to the classroom program.*

Upon completion of all the program requirements, including SWOSU Rural Health Center having a copy of your current CPR card by **August 1, 2017**, a Statement of Credit will be mailed to each participant from the Southwestern Pharmacy Foundation Continuing Education Office. Participants who complete the Immunization Training Program will also receive a SWOSU College of Pharmacy Rural Health Center Certificate that will satisfy the training required by the Oklahoma State Board of Pharmacy for pharmacists to become registered to administer immunizations.

*IMMUNIZATION TRAINING NOTE: The Southwestern Pharmacy Immunization Training Program meets Oklahoma State Board of Pharmacy requirements for pharmacist immunization certification. You are responsible for verifying with any other state board of pharmacy for their approval.*

*CONTINUING EDUCATION NOTE: The Immunization Training Program is approved for a total of 12 hours of Continuing Education by the Oklahoma State Board of Pharmacy (this is not an ACPE provider program). Please check with your board(s) of pharmacy to determine if this program is acceptable for your license renewal.*

## REGISTRATION AND FEES - SPACE IS LIMITED, SO REGISTER EARLY!

Early registration fee of \$275 per person must be paid by June 20. After June 20, late registration fee is \$350 per person (acceptance of late registration is subject to space availability). Class size is limited to 30 pharmacists.

## REFUNDS

Refunds for the Immunization Training Program will be refunded in full if cancellation notice is received in the Rural Health Center's office before July 1. Cancellations received after July 1 will be subject to a 50% cancellation fee. No refunds after July 14.
