My name is Jim Hrcir RPh (1979 SWOSU pharmacy graduate) and I own and operate Las Colinas Pharmacy in Irving, Texas. I opened Las Colinas Pharmacy in 1984 on the basis of personal patient service. In our three compounding labs, we are known for expertise in dermatology, pain management (both topical, trans-dermal, sterile, intrathecal, and oral) Bio-Identical hormones, veterinary and nutritional. Our sterile lab is fully compliant with the tough new USP 797 rules.

Doctors and other providers in our area also look to us to provide ethical and evidence based advice on a variety of topics in natural medicine, including functional medicine, homeopathy, nutrition, and weight loss. We have an extensive vitamin department stocked with only the most respected and ethical brands and employ a full time nutritionist.

PHARMACIST-IN-CHARGE

The Veterinary Pharmacy (TVP), a retail pharmacy located in Newcastle, Oklahoma (18 miles SW of central Oklahoma City), has an opening for a part-time, permanent pharmacist-in-charge (PIC). The position is open immediately.

DEFINITION

Under general direction, the PIC ensures compliance with all applicable laws and regulations for the State of Oklahoma for a single, independently standing Oklahoma chartered pharmacy; compounds and dispenses prescriptions upon the order of a licensed veterinarian; supervises staff pharmacists and technicians and performs related duties as required.

EXAMPLES OF DUTIES

1. Maintains all records of all transactions of the pharmacy operations necessary to ensure accurate control over and accountability for drugs as required by applicable state regulations, federal statutes and the FDA; includes legal operation of the pharmacy, including all inspections and other requirements by state and federal agencies for the preparations of Biobullet, a trademark dosage form.
2. Fills and compounds prescriptions for pharmaceutical preparations and devices, consults with veterinarians and cattle producers, and interacts with the staff of SolidTech Animal Health, Inc; learns the use and procedures for an innovative dosage form; monitors storage, distribution and use of the prepared prescriptions for shipping.
3. Supervises and maintains a clean room within the pharmacy; maintains quality assurance.
4. Must be a licensed preceptor with the State of Oklahoma and willing to instruct students enrolled in the SWOSU College of Pharmacy at the Newcastle location.

EMPLOYMENT STANDARDS

1. Possession and in good standing of an Oklahoma Pharmacy license.
2. Be willing to obtain a pharmacy license in additional states at the company's expense while serving as the PIC to which TVP ships.
3. Knowledge of compounding pharmacy, clean room and aseptic technique.
4. Develop operating procedures as required and ensure those procedures are observed.
5. Communicate effectively both orally and in writing.
